

Fountainhead Regional Park

A large multi-use park at the widest point of the Occoquan Reservoir sits amidst hardwoods, mountain laurel and wild rhododendrons. Accessible fishing pier, licenses and bait; jonboat, canoe, kayak and equipment rentals at marina building. Designated mountain bike trail, bridle and hiking trails on site. Seasonal access.
